Learn More about Emission Monitoring and Testing Requirements for Combustion Turbines

Even with increased reliance on renewables, combustion turbine generation has grown, and new installations continue. Whether to address new base-load demand or for cycling or peaking needs, utilities are turning to combustion turbines, which are quickly becoming the workhorses of the fleet. Addressing permitting and emission monitoring requirements is an important part of commissioning these new sources. Permit limits, emission controls, and monitoring requirements can vary depending on the location and type of turbine while ultra-low NO_x limits and managing ammonia slip can present monitoring challenges. CEMS certification, initial compliance tests and the associated reporting requirements all must be met within the regulatory deadlines even in situations where the transition of ownership may make ensuring compliance difficult.

Whether you are in the process of installing a new turbine, considering adding new generation or simply want to be better informed, this half-day webinar is intended to help you navigate the process and understand the requirements. Topics will include:
